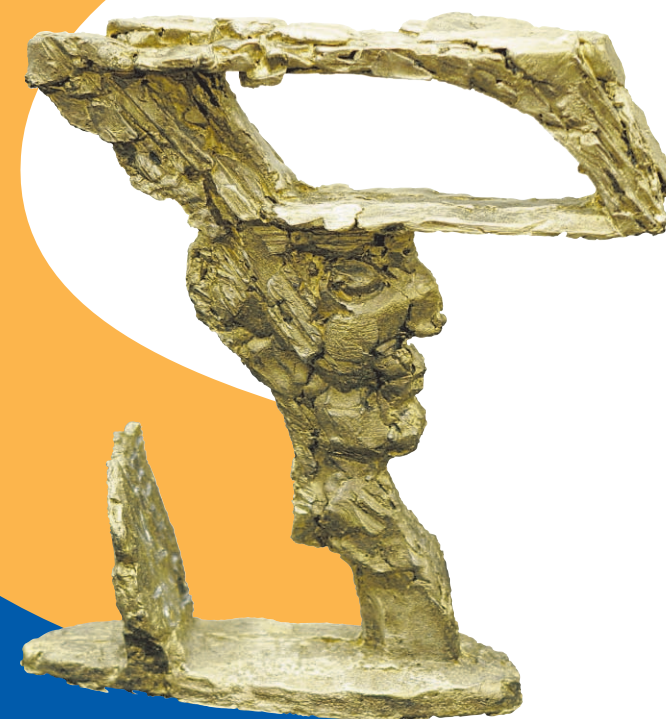

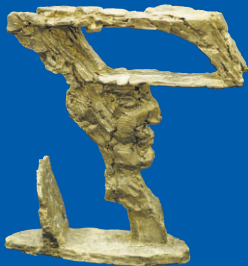

STATUTES



BASIC PROVISIONS

1. The aim of the TECHFILM festival is to collect, present, award and make accessible the latest programmes from the fields of science, technology and arts as well as multimedia and training products contributing to a better education.
2. The aim of the EMTECH conference is to arrange a discussion forum on activities related to the development of university studies, life-long education and education of handicapped people.
3. The main event of the Festival is the International Film Competition, the Panorama Section and Educational Products Contest.
4. The main event of the Conference is an international space for discussions, workshops and presentations.
5. The main topic is Technology for life in 21st century – modernisation of urban life, communications technology, building industry, road-traffic infrastructure, libraries etc.

INTERNATIONAL COMPETITION AND PANORAMA SECTION

1. The Board of Selection decides which programmes will be accepted for the International competition and which ones for the Panorama section.
2. The films included into the International Competition will be judged by the International Jury, the ones in the Panorama Section will be just presented.

3. The International Jury

- a) Bestows the statutory awards
- b) Recommends programmes for non-statutory awards
- c) Has the right to award additional prizes
- d) Has the right not to award some of the prizes

4. The statutory awards are bestowed to the entrants.

5. International Competition statutory awards

- TECHFILM 2009 GRAND PRIX
- International Jury Prize
- Prize for Best Popular-Science Programme
- Prize for Best Educational Programme
- Prize for Best Work of Art
- Prize for Best Commercial Programme

6. International Competition non-statutory awards

- Award of the Rector of CTU in Prague for a foreign film presenting new technology
- Award of the Mayor Of the Municipal District Prague 6 for a Czech film dealing with municipal policy
- Award of the Czech TV for the best foreign TV film
- Award of the Hlavka Foundation for a young artist
- The Audience Award

REQUIREMENTS FOR JOINING IN THE INTERNATIONAL CONTEST AND PANORAMA SECTION

1. A programme may be entered by its producers, creators, distributors or authors. There is no entrance fee for the programme.
2. The Festival International competition is open to programmes made after 1st January 2008 only; the Panorama section is open to works made after 1st January 2007. The length of the programme must not exceed 60 minutes. We accept programmes in the following formats: DVD, CD and VHS – all in the PAL standard. Programme applications for the Board of Selection labelled TECHFILM must reach the relevant address (see the application form) before 31st December 2008. Each film-entry must be accompanied by 2 copies of the programme and a complete commentary or dialogue list in Czech or English language.
3. The Board of Selection will not judge any programme-entries that do not match up to the points 1–2.
4. The applicants will be informed about selection of their programmes for the International competition or the Panorama section. If a programme was selected for the International Competition two copies of that programme on DVD discs must be sent to the TECHFILM address.
5. All award-winning programmes will remain in the TECHFILM archive.
6. Festival organisers guarantee the programmes will not be used to any commercial purposes. Festival programmes can be used for educational presentation and a selection of awarded programmes will be presented in Czech TV as a part of the Festival promotion.

EDUCATIONAL PRODUCTS CONTEST

1. The aim of the Contest is to present the best educational products created in the last two years in order to support the production in this area.
 2. The Board of Selection decides which products will be accepted for the competition.
 3. The educational products will be judged and awarded by the Professional Jury. Selected products will be presented on the Festival.

6. Organisers of the Contest have the right to extend the number of awards or not to award some of the prizes.

REQUIREMENTS FOR JOINING IN THE EDUCATIONAL PRODUCTS CONTEST

1. Products can be entered by schools, institutions and companies from Czech and Slovak Republic. No fees required.
2. The application forms for the Contest together with 2 copies of entered product must reach the organiser's address before 31st December 2008 labelled „TECHFILM“.
3. All received materials will remain in the Multimedia Library of CTU in Prague. The Festival organisers guarantee they will not be used to any commercial purposes.

PERSONAL PARTICIPATION

1. Application forms for the personal participation must be sent before 15th February 2009 to the organiser's address or via the electronic form on <http://emtech.cvut.cz>.
